

**RESOLUTION 11-25 TO APPROVE DISSEMINATION OF A REQUEST FOR  
QUALIFICATIONS FOR FARMING OPERATIONS**

WHEREAS, the Front Range Airport Authority (the "Authority") was created pursuant to the Public Airport Authority Act, Article 3 of Title 41, Colorado Revised Statutes, in September 27, 1982, by the Board of County Commissioners of Adams County; and,

WHEREAS, the Authority has constructed and financed a general aviation airport (the "Airport") in Adams County, Colorado; and,

WHEREAS, the Authority and the County are authorized by the law to enter into contracts and agreements affecting the affairs of the Airport; and,

WHEREAS, the Authority owns just under 4,000-acres of land, of which approximately 2,000-acres are used for farming on a 1/3 share basis; and,

WHEREAS, the Authority entered into a two year farming agreement, which terminates September 13, 2012, and has an automatic renew for three years unless terminated by either party; and,

WHEREAS, dry land farming requires land that has produced a crop to lay fallow for the following year, resulting in different applications of tilling, fertilizing and seeding for various portions of the farming ground and therefore do not have a date certain when the whole of farming ends.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Authority approves the Director to publish a request for qualifications for farming operations on Front Range Airport; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED the Authority approves the Director to develop a selection process and with approval as to form by General Counsel present the two top companies to the board for final selection.
